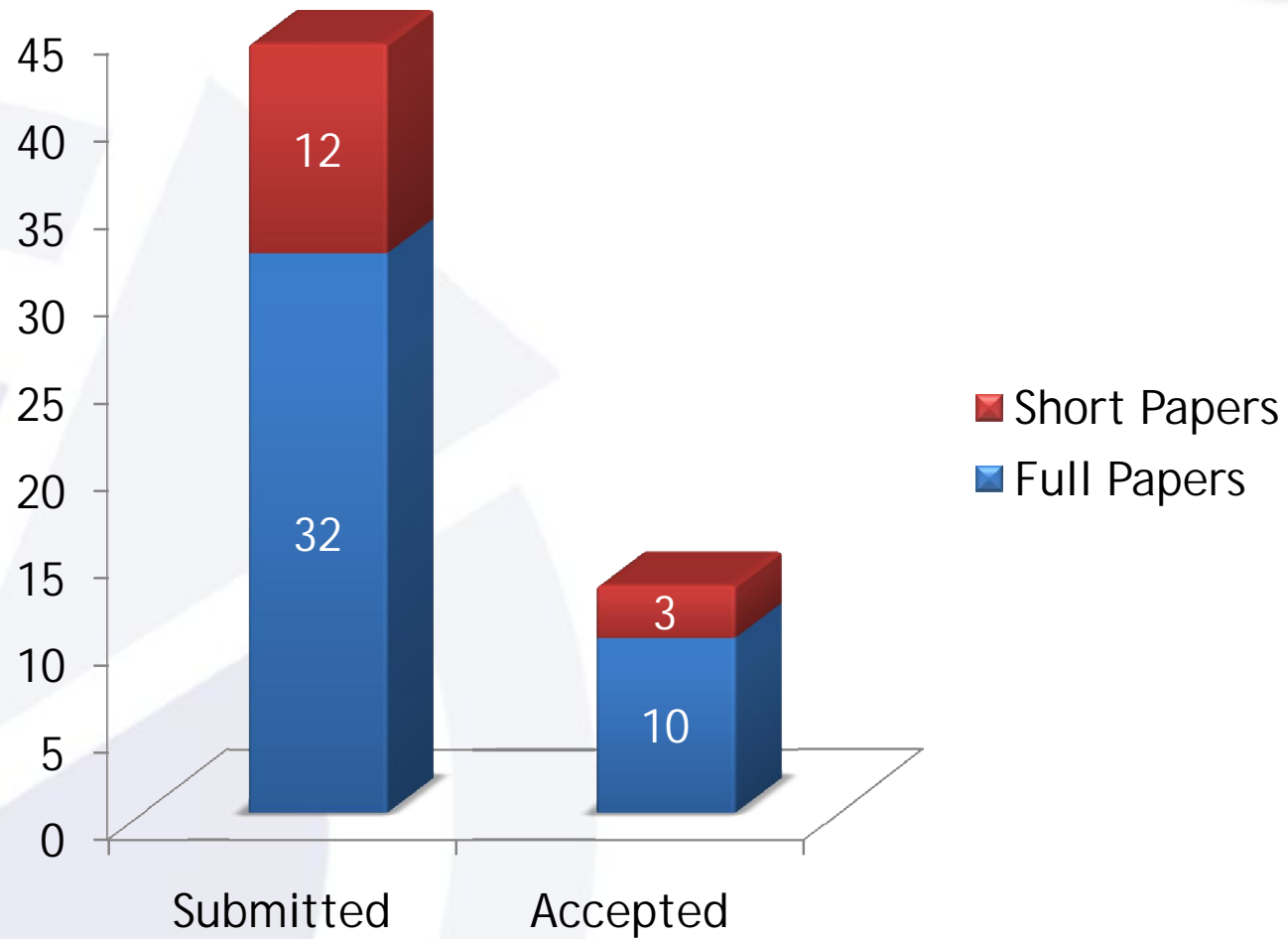

- 13 paper accepted for publication

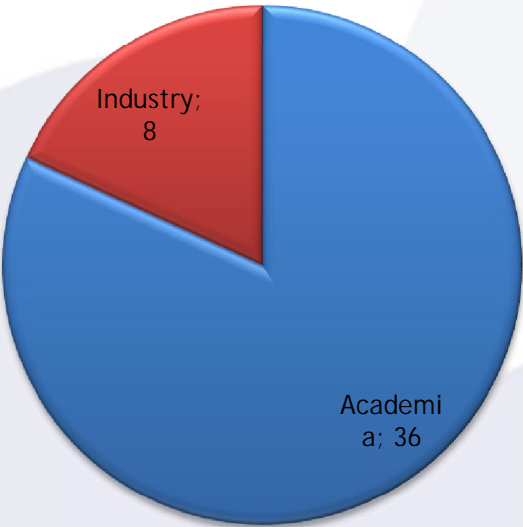

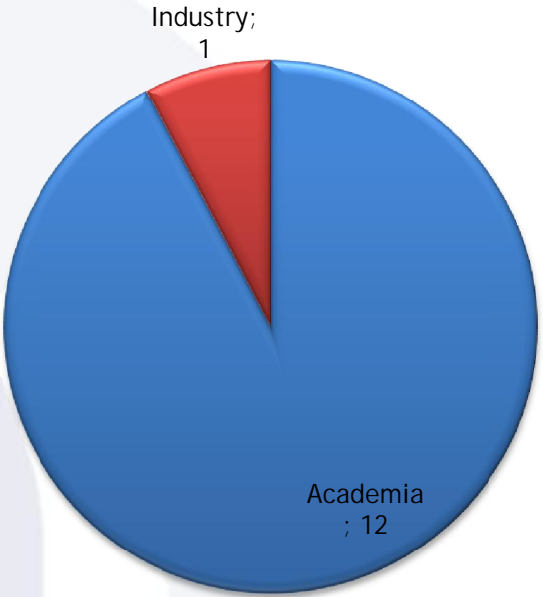

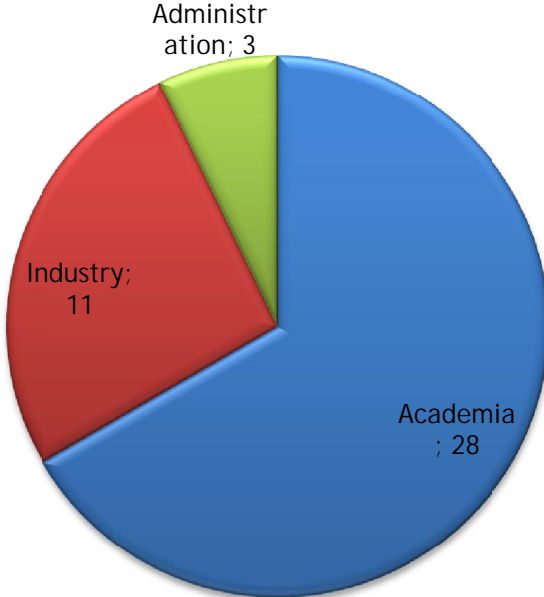
